I have just returned from United States after several weeks of absence. We are now studying in Lima the subjects who will be taken up to Morococha to be followed for a period of one month. The iron we have (Fe^{59}) is enough for the investigation of about eight subjects and we would like to have sufficient isotope to have at least twenty subjects investigated, taking into account that they will remain in Morococha for different periods of time. Will you kindly arrange for the shipment of this additional amount of Fe^{59} ? After this we will not need any further remittance until the men are taken up to Morococha (about September). I have decided to go up to London in August so it will be a pleasure to see you up there.
