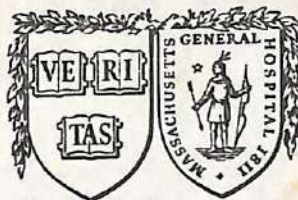


Dear Dr. Hurtado:
