Dear dr. Hurtado,

Thank you for your letter from New York and for your kind words about my coming to Lima. Through professor Forssman, who has close connections with WHO and who is going to Genève in a week or so, I shall try to get more informations. I have told Forssman about your group and asked him to inform people at the ILO about your existens and your working program. I should think it would be a good idea if you would contact Mr. Lozada. Even if he is not a medical man himself he should be able to understand that you in some way should be in on the project. My proposal to Forssman, which he will get on to ILO, is that I go to South America, if they want me to do so, but that I start the work in close contact with you, and that you and your group take over entirely when I leave after a year or so.

My department has been doing rather extensive work in the field of industrial physiology during the last 4 years and we may be able to contribute to the program in Bolivia from our point of view, as far as job analysis, determination of working capacity etc.
