Dear Dr. Hurtado:

I just received a request from The Rockefeller Foundation to quote on a 'Standard' four speed , $2\frac{1}{2}$ - 10 m.p.h. treadmill; constant horse power motor.

The standard, Type 10, treadmill is for grown-ups and require a 3 HP. motor.

I thought when I talked with you that we might use a four speed motor; but I find now that a motor like that would weigh 700 lbs. Would be too big (the frame of a 15 HP. motor) and might tip the treadmill upward.

We better stick to the P.I.V. unit for Type 10 treadmills.

If you want a Type 8 - Same speeds, for childrens or animals a 1 HP. constant, has worked out very well.

Please let me know soon what you want so I can give Rock. Found. an estimate.
