Dear Alberto:

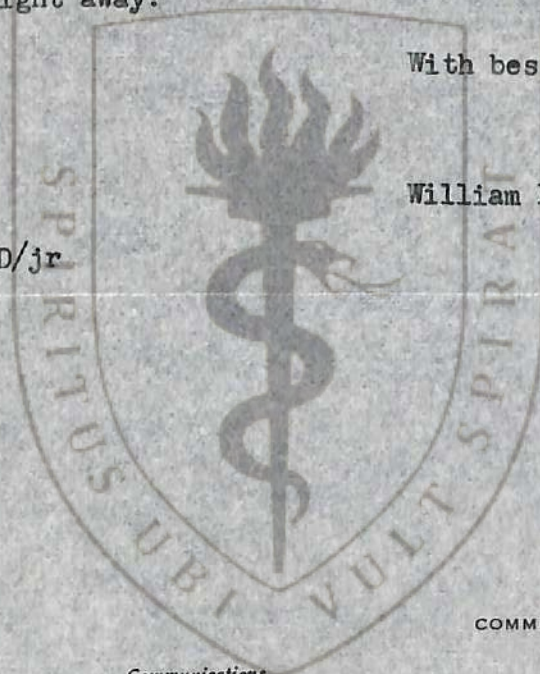
